MM Certification Procedures.

Full MM certification requires that the therapist complete 2 post practice cases. If the Informed Consent at your sites allows it, you can use Pilot 3, Cell 10 participants towards the process of certification. If the actual cases do not include all types of sessions (AC, ANC, NAC, NANC), the training center may request additional tapes. The training center has prepared two role-play scenarios that each new therapist is required to complete in lieu of actual cases. These include 2 clients with an initial and 4 follow-ups sessions each. Instructions for the role-plays are included in the MM Manual and are also available from the training center. The sessions are to be recorded and the tapes and session record forms for the sessions sent to the training center. The training center will also send out an assessment packet to the new therapist. It is up to the therapist whether or not they wish to complete the assessments. However, the first page that acknowledges the taping of sessions must be completed before any feedback will be sent from the training center. Once that is done, the training center will provide written feedback on all of the certification sessions. The therapist must pass all of the sessions for full approval.
